I apologize for not paying too close attention to the occasional msgs about communications packages for the II+, so this may have already been answered, but I'll ask again anyway. I'm looking for a communications package/ terminal emulator (though that's not so important) with the following constraints:

- 1) runs on Apple II+
- 2) uses the Applied Engineering 80 col card (Videx compatible?)
- 3) handles a Hayes SmartModem at 1200 baud
- 4) can upload/download files on the Apple disk using X-on/X-off protocol
- 5) can also copy to a printer (MX-80, though the type is probably not relevant.)
- 6) full character set (shift-key mod)
- 7) would be nice, but not essential, to emulate any terminal on which EMACS works well
